VILLAGE OF PLEASANTVILLE LOCAL LAW TO AMEND
CHAPTER 173, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 60
OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PLEASANTVILLE

A LOCAL LAW to amend Chapter 173, Article VII, Section 60, of the Code of the Village of Pleasantville concerning parking on Washington Avenue.

Section 1. Chapter 173, Article VII, Section 60 of the Code of the Village of Pleasantville entitled “Schedule XII: Parking Prohibited at All Times” is hereby amended to prohibit parking on Washington Avenue from the intersection of Hildreth Place as follows:

§ 173-60 Schedule XII: Parking Prohibited at All Times.

In accordance with the provisions of § 173-16, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts thereof:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Washington Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From Hildreth Place south for 30 feet</u>
<u>Washington Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From Hildreth Place north for 38 feet</u>

Section 2. Ratification, Re-adoption and Confirmation

Except as specifically modified by the amendments contained herein, Chapter 173, Article VII, Section 60 of the Village Code of the Village of Pleasantville are otherwise to remain in full force and effect and are otherwise ratified, readopted and confirmed.

Section 3. Numbering for Codification

It is the intention of the Village of Pleasantville and it is hereby enacted that the provisions of this Local Law shall be included in the Code of the Village of Pleasantville; that the sections and subsections of this Local Law may be re-numbered or re-lettered by the Codifier to accomplish such intention; that the Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Local Law; that the word “ Local Law” shall be changed to “Chapter,” “ Section” or other appropriate word as required for codification; and that any such rearranging of the numbering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Local Law or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this chapter or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this chapter, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
