Subject: Pleasantville Fire Department – 75 Washington Avenue – Site Plan Application

- The generator is for use during times of power outages. However, the generator will be exercised once a week. We recommend that the weekly operation be during midday hours to lessen the impact of the sound to the Village area.
- 2. At the September meeting, the Commission had requested that the generator be located next to the building, preferably in the same location as the existing generator. The generator has been relocated to the northern side of the parking lot next to the building. The Applicant should clarify why the unit cannot be located in the same place as the existing generator.
- 3. The previously proposed gas-powered generator has been replace with a diesel generator. The diesel-powered generator appears to be much taller that the previously proposed unit. It also has a higher decibel level. The Applicant should explain to the Commission why the diesel is the preferred unit.
- 4. At the September meeting, the Commission had requested decibel level information for the existing generator. The Commission also requested a "breakdown" of what would be powered by the generator. This information was not included in the submission.
- 5. We recommend that additional screening be provided for the proposed generator.
