Dear Stephanie,

Please accept this letter as my formal notice of resignation from Pleasantville as a Court Attendant, effective June 30, 2022. The time in Pleasantville will truly be memorable. Working with you has been great!

There are duties within the court attendant job description that cannot be enforced or carried out as a civilian, such as take charge of prisoners, ability to qualify in handling firearms etc. As stated under special note (job description). We are not peace officers and should not be asked to do any enforcement duties, we're civilian and when or if we're assaulted it will be consider a simple assault as a civilian that ultimately it will be pre-bargained into a disorderly conduct, which may lead to both civil suit and criminal charges. If assaulted as peace officer that carry a minimal sentence and usually isn't pre-bargained. As civilians we do not have qualified amenity nor are we indemnified by the state this opens us to civil suits and possible criminal charges for doing our jobs.

I hope a two-month notice is sufficient for you to find a replacement for me. If I can help to train my replacement or tie up any loose ends please do not hesitate to ask me.
